Within the final Conference of the *Children as vulnerable users of IOT and AI-based technologies: a multi-level interdisciplinary assessment (CURA) PRIN 2022* funded project, we invite contributions exploring the following profiles, also adopting an interdisciplinary perspective:

- Fundamental Rights Impact Assessments methodologies for children as AI-based systems;
- Children's Rights assessment methodologies under the Digital Services Act;
- Search of origins and digital platforms;
- The AI and digital literacy and education with and for children;
- The role of Age-verification techniques to foster children's contractual autonomy in the digital dimension;
- To enhance children's inclusion through digitalization;
- To foster participation in decision-making process for specific sectors (education, audiovisual economy, healthcare, etc.).

Scholars interested in submitting a contribution on the above-mentioned topics are invited to send, by **15.05.2025** a paper (*max* 25.000 characters including spaces) in English within this form <https://docs.google.com/forms/d/e/1FAIpQLSd0jXdhV-esP5cNvzxx0aRIIdAfRyRfRUatpw9-ZJA7TVzGlsW/viewform>

Papers shall include a short abstract and a table of contents. Kindly use Times new roman 12, lines 1.15. Footnotes OSCOLA referencing style.

All submissions will be reviewed and selected by the Conference's Scientific Committee. Results will be communicated by June 20<sup>th</sup> 2025.

Selected papers will be part of a special issue, subjected to double blind peer-review and published in *Opinio Juris in Comparatione* (<https://www.opiniojurisincomparatione.org>).

Authors of selected papers will be expected to present their research in person at the Conference in Pisa on September 25<sup>th</sup> 2025.

Panels will be organized around specific themes rather than disciplinary clusters, with the goal of encouraging dialogue across disciplines and reducing fragmentation among academic fields.
